



## WASH AGAINST WASTE TEAM SPECIFICATION

### About Energy Breakthrough

The Energy Breakthrough is a unique multiple day youth event held in November in Maryborough annually. The event commenced in 1991, and has been held at the Princes Park Precinct, Maryborough every year since.

The EB attracts in excess of 5,000 participants who camp and participate in the various categories conducted as part of the event. In partnership with our food vendors, EB has introduced a wash against waste system, avoiding hundreds of kgs of single use packaging waste each year.

### What is involved

We need people power to help this system run smoothly and are seeking support from our local community groups!

Council is seeking a community group for a Wash Against Waste Team for the next one to three events.

Key tasks include:

- Collect dirty dishes from designated areas around the site
- Remove food scraps and pre-wash dishes by hand
- Load dish washing machine with pre-washed dishes
- Remove clean dishes from machine and dry with tea towel
- Stack dishes and distribute to vendors
- Engagement with vendors and patrons

### Dates required:

- Tuesday 19 – Sunday 24 November 2024
- Tuesday 18 – Sunday 23 November 2025 (Optional)
- Tuesday 17 – Sunday 22 November 2026 (TBC) (Optional)

### Expected behaviour

The Wash Against Waste station will be prominently located within EB Central. Collection points for dirty dishes will be throughout the site.

We expect our Wash Against Waste team to behave in a respectful manner when interacting with patrons and vendors. The team should look to promote the event's waste wise message where possible.

There is no expectation to tolerate any antisocial behaviour directed at the Wash Against Waste Team. Team members can report any issues at the Energy Breakthrough Hub.

### Shift requirements

Below is an indication of shift requirements throughout the event. At least two staff will be required during each shift.

If you do not have the capacity to fill all shifts, please advise the hours and number of staff you would be able to provide for each day.

Energy Breakthrough will work with the successful community group/s to refine the schedule before the event, making sure all needs are met.
